LEXINGTON AVENUE TO BE CLOSED AT NORTH MAIN STREET INTERSECTION

High Point, N.C. (Jan. 10, 2020) – Lexington Avenue will be closed at its intersection with North Main Street in High Point, N.C. beginning Wednesday, Jan. 15, 2020, for a City construction project to improve pedestrian crossings, update public water and sewer and install an underground electric duct bank, mast arms and traffic signals.

The project will last for approximately 230 days, with construction taking place until the beginning of the 2020 spring furniture market. During market, work will cease, and pavement will be patched and marked to allow full traffic flow. Construction will resume after the spring market is over and is expected to be completed by September 2020.
