COLTRANE PROJECT OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE HOSTS COMMUNITY INPUT MEETING

High Point, N.C. (Jan. 23, 2020) – The Coltrane Project Oversight Committee will host a community presentation on Thursday, Jan. 30, 2020, at 6 p.m. at the Penn-Griffin School for the Arts, located at 825 Washington St.

At the presentation, residents will learn about the historic John Coltrane childhood home here in High Point, N.C. and provide feedback on its future use.

The Coltrane Project Oversight Committee is composed of High Point residents, city staff and elected officials tasked with implementing a plan to transform the historic home into a revitalized community asset that highlights community and celebrates the legacy of the late world-renowned jazz artist John Coltrane.
