



Recycling saves landfill space, preserves our natural resources, lowers oil imports and protects the environment. It is one of the easiest ways to make a difference. If you look at your weekly garbage contents, most people find that you can recycle about half of what is normally thrown away.
Recycle and make a difference!

The City of High Point has provided each resident one (1) 95 gallon recycling cart. Recyclables are picked up every other week from the curb on your regular garbage collection day. Educational information is on the lid of the cart and serves as a guide for what is acceptable to place in the cart.

Recycling check list:

- Cart at curb by 7:00 a.m.
- Cart handle & wheels facing the house
- Cart has 3 foot of clearance from obstructions (mail box, cars, garbage cart, etc...)
- Cart is 3/4 full or more
- No garbage in cart
- No large boxes that do not fit in cart (take to drop off location) Click on [Drop-Off Locations](#) or call 883-3111 for the location nearest you.
- All materials are in the cart (not placed beside it)

Please do not mix garbage with recyclables in the cart. This increases the cost for sorting and disposal. If garbage is found in the recycling cart, the cart will be tagged and recorded for violating the City's Solid Waste Ordinance. Continued violations will result in the material not being collected and/or fines being issued.

If you have lots of recyclables, you may wish to purchase an additional recycling cart. There is a maximum of 2 recycling carts service for each residence. Call 883-3111 to purchase one or [order one online](#). Payment methods include bringing \$57.00 to the City Collector's office at 211 South Hamilton Street, purchasing online or by mailing a check to: City Collector, P.O. Box 230, High Point, NC 27261. The original carts provided at no cost to residents, belong to the City and must remain with the house they have been assigned to. If you move, please leave the cart behind.
