Summary

The Practicum student will be introduced to working in the community-based setting that provides programs for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The Practicum student will shadow an LRT/CTRS, Program Coordinator, Park & Recreational professional and Camp staff.

- Plan, develop and implement programs for youth, teens and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities
- Plan, implement and lead up to three soccer practices through the High Point Challenger Soccer program
- Communicate well with players, coaching staff, families and volunteers
- Assist with summer camps and lead activities
- Assist with Miracle League of High Point program
- Assist with Special Olympics Guilford/High Point program
- Related work as required, such as TR process with a program participant
